

For every student that attends NBCC's Open House, they will be eligible for our prize draw. Limit one entry per person, per event

The draw prize is one (2) \$500 NBCC tuition credits. In order for a student to be eligible for the \$500 tuition credit, they must register and attend an NBCC program for Fall 2025, Spring 2025, or Winter 2026.

The winner will be selected at random from all eligible entries during the week of March 24th, 2025. The selected entrant will be contacted by phone or email. Up to three attempts to contact a potential winner will be made. After three unsuccessful attempts have been made to contact the potential winner within 5 business days, another name will be drawn. This process will be repeated until the prize has been awarded.

The prizes are non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and is not redeemable for cash or other prizes. NBCC retains the right to substitute the prize with another prize of similar value in the event the original prize offered is not available.

All decisions of the independent judging organization are final. The prize will be awarded and delivered to the confirmed winner by NBCC. All entries become the property of NBCC. No responsibility will be taken for entries lost, misdirected or delayed. The winner will be required to release NBCC and its agencies and representatives from liability with respect to the contest and the prize.

The contest is open to Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada except employees of NBCC, their associated companies and agents and members of their immediate families living in the same household.
