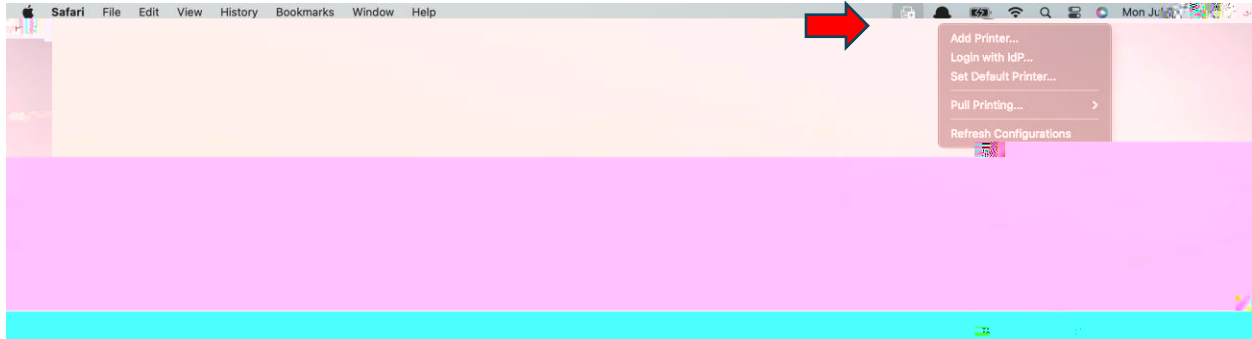
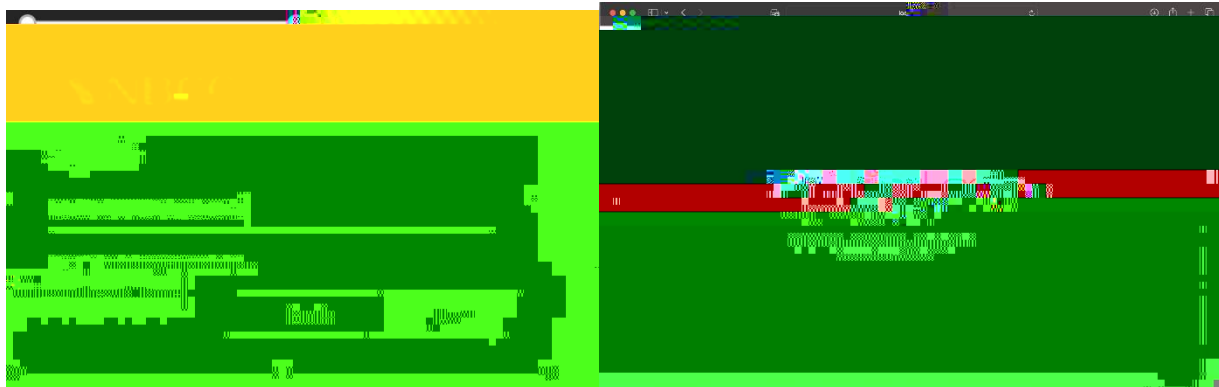


How to connect to a printer on Mac

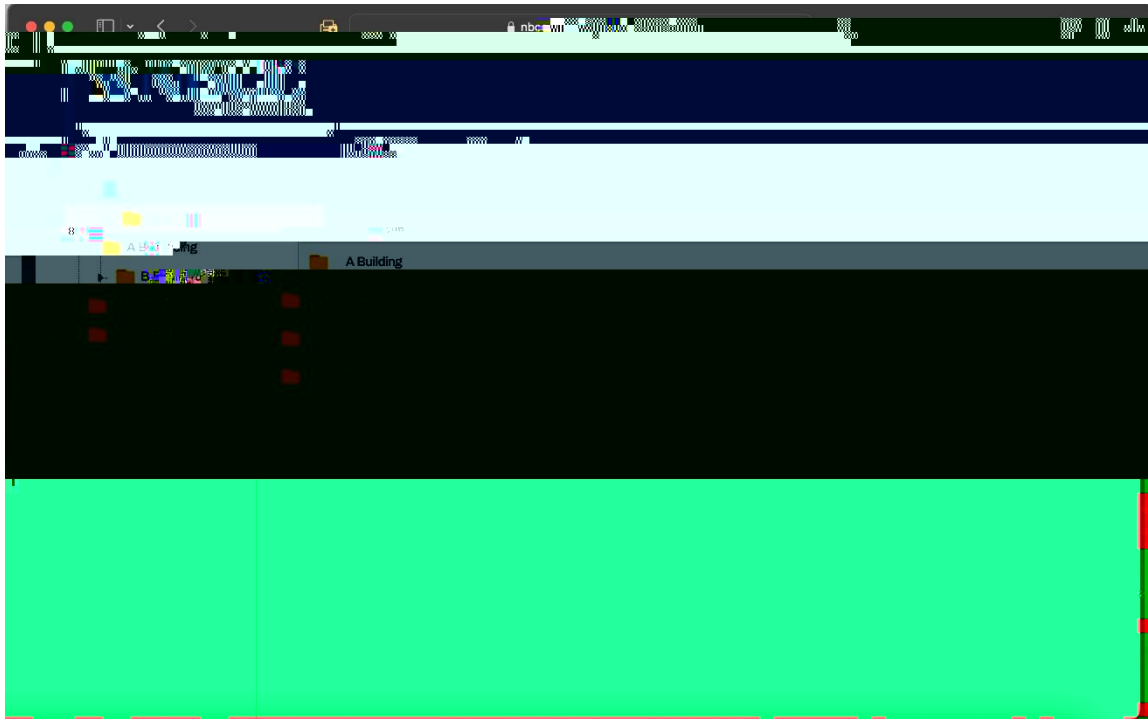
Step 1: on the top right of your mac screen you will see the printer logic client icon. Click on the icon and if your not already logged in choose the option log in with idp.



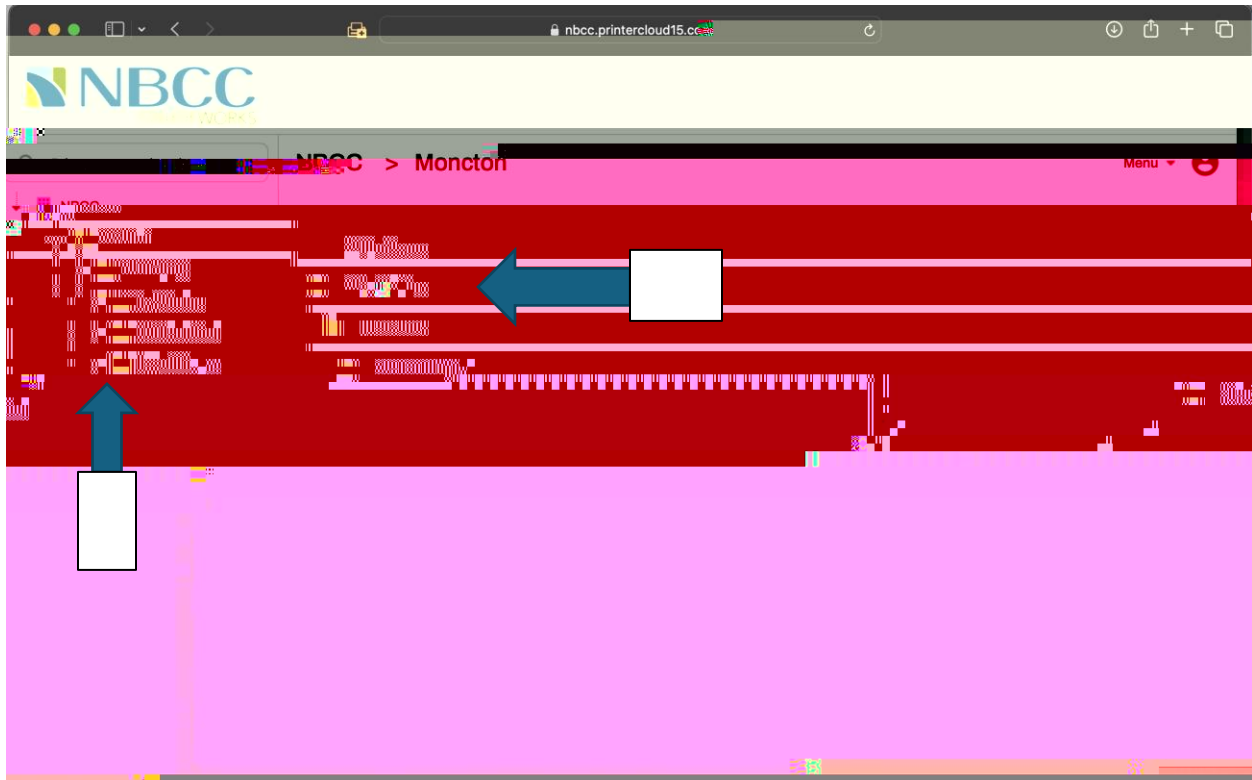
Step 2: Once you click log in with idp you will be prompted to sign in with your student credentials. Example tstudent01@mynbcc.ca. After you log in you will get a notification from printer logic that your log in was successful.



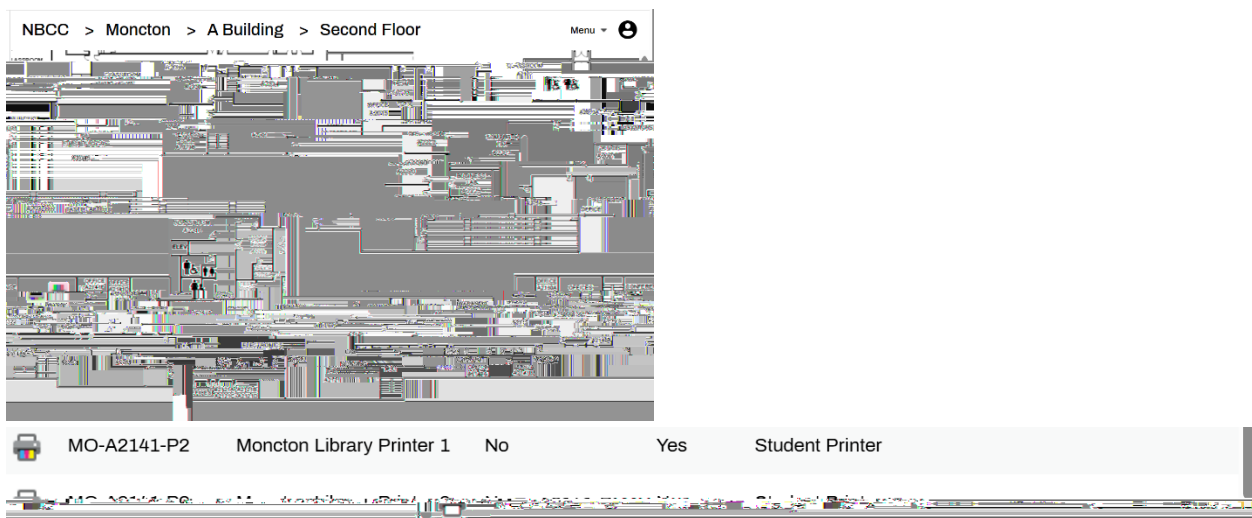
Step 3: After you sign in with your NBCC account, you will repeat the process in step 1 and choose add printer. This will open safari and bring you to the NBCC branded printer logic site (<https://nbcc.printercloud15.com>). On the webpage you will see only student printers from the campus you are attending. Example: If you are a Moncton campus student you will only see the student printers for Moncton



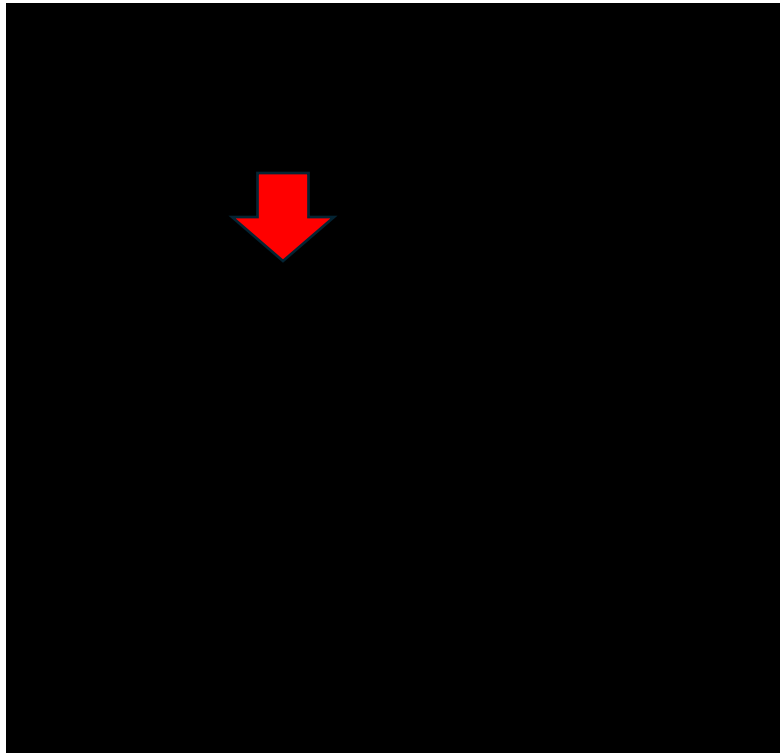
Step 4: From the left-hand side of the webpage click on the building and floor that you want to add a student printer from. Example A building on the second floor.



Step 5: You will be presented with a map of the campus floor with the location of each printer or if you scroll down to the bottom of the webpage you will have a list of all the available printers.



Step 6: Once you have identified the printer you want to install, click install from the map section or click once on the printer from the list section.



After clicking the printer icon, you will get prompted to confirm the installation of the printer. You will also be presented with the option to have the printer set as your default.
